

Clubhouse Parking Notice Please be reminded that blocking the clubhouse entrance

is not only illegal but inconsiderate and inconvenient for other residents and guests entering and exiting the front entrance of the clubhouse.

Monthly Fees/Drop Box

If you put your check for the monthly fees in the drop box outside the office please either seal the envelope or do not use one. The damp, humid weather causes the envelope glue to seal to the check and often we are unable to separate them and will have to request a replacement check from you.

Trash and Recycling Schedule

Recycling pick-up is every Thursday. Please have your recyclables curbside by 7:00am. NOTE: No plastic bags or styrofoam in recycle bins please.

Trash pick-up is every Thursday. Please have your garbage curbside by 7:00am in 32 gallon containers with lids or in sealed 32 gallon plastic bags not weighing more than 50 pounds. DO NOT mix with yard waste.

Yard Waste must be tied in bundles not more than 4' in length, 4" in diameter and leaves and grass clippings should be in 32 gallon lawn bags or 32 gallon garbage cans weighing 50 pounds or less. DO NOT mix with garbage. NO loose piles will be picked up.

We began a new year of Pickleball on Tuesdays and Fridays at 9:00 AM.


